### **GENERAL RULES FOR ALL SHOWS**

- \*\*NEW 2025\*\* Maximum weight for any lamb entered in the Heartbeat of The South (Southern Gal Showdown, Summer Heat Showdown, GCLA Futurity) will be <u>140 lbs</u> <u>ALL SHEEP ALL SHOWS</u> <u>NO EXCEPTIONS or GRACE. 140LB MAX</u>
- \*\*\*\*For the consideration of all exhibitors, sheep must be free of fungus, and show NO signs of active fungus. Health papers are <u>**REQUIRED**</u> and <u>**MUST**</u> be available at time of Check-In. The GCLA board reserves the right to disqualify sheep for not abiding by the aforementioned rule.
- Exhibitors must NOT have completed high school.
- Lambs will be classified ONCE for ALL three (3) shows. Classifications will be determined prior to weigh in.
- Lambs will be classified as: Hair, White Face, Natural, or Black Face.
- A minimum of seven (7) lambs will be required to make a breed classification.
- Showmanship classes will be K-12<sup>th</sup> based on the grade you are entering in Fall of 2025. Showmanship will start with 12<sup>th</sup> Grade and continue through K Saturday and Sunday. We will have a Pee Wee Class Saturday and Sunday immediately following K Showmanship
- Pens are \$15 per pen and will be assigned. Please ONLY take pens that are assigned to you. <u>SHAVINGS</u>
  <u>WILL NOT BE PROVIDED</u> Please bring your own. Shavings will be available for purchase at the Fairgrounds. Please indicate on entry any penning preferences. Pens are a direct cost from the Georgia National Fairgrounds GCLA makes no profit from pens.
- Shirts will be ordered on Showman App. Deadline to order shirts will be **June 15, 2025. \$20** per Shirt.
- NO showing off trailers. All trailers MUST be parked in designated trailer parking within 30 minutes of unloading tack.
- All sheep MUST remain in barn during the show weekend AND must be no further than 50 feet from the barn at all times.
- Any tents set up for the show may only have two (2) side walls.
- Alcoholic beverages are <u>NOT</u> permitted ANYWHERE/ANYTIME on the Georgia National Fairgrounds

  - \* Age Divisions will be broken in Senior (9<sup>th</sup> 12<sup>th</sup> grade), Intermediate (5<sup>th</sup> 8<sup>th</sup> grade), and Junior (K 4<sup>th</sup> grade). Sign Up in New South Arena Thursday morning
  - \* Awards will be given to the top 3 in each age division.
  - \* Quiz make up will be general knowledge of sheep (age appropriate) with hands on exercises

- \* \$10.00 Per Person \$20.00 Per Team
- \* Teams are to be made up of one youth exhibitor (8<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade) and one youth exhibitor (7<sup>th</sup> grade and under).
- \* One team member will clip one side of the lamb and the other team member will clip the opposite side of the lamb. Senior may

- \* Show is open to any student that has not yet completed high school.
- \* Ewes and Wethers will be shown TOGETHER.
- \* Classes will be determined by WEIGHT and CLASSIFICATION.

- \* For any Youth Exhibitor to accumulate GCLA points for the 2025 show season, you MUST submit/pay your membership and update your youth enrollment forms two (2) weeks prior to show (June 20, 2025 to get points for Heartbeat shows)
- \* Only sheep that are born and bred in Georgia and nominated with the GCLA are eligible for the Futurity show on Sunday. (Please see additional GCLA membership/breeder rules for more information).
- \* Exhibitors showing the Futurity show on Sunday MUST be current GCLA Youth Members. Youth enrollment in the point system is not required.
- \* Breeders of nominated and enrolled sheep must be in good standing with the GCLA.
- \* All grievances should be brought to the attention of a GCLA board member in writing with a \$50 grievance fee. Grievances will be discussed by the GCLA Board and all decisions made will be FINAL.
